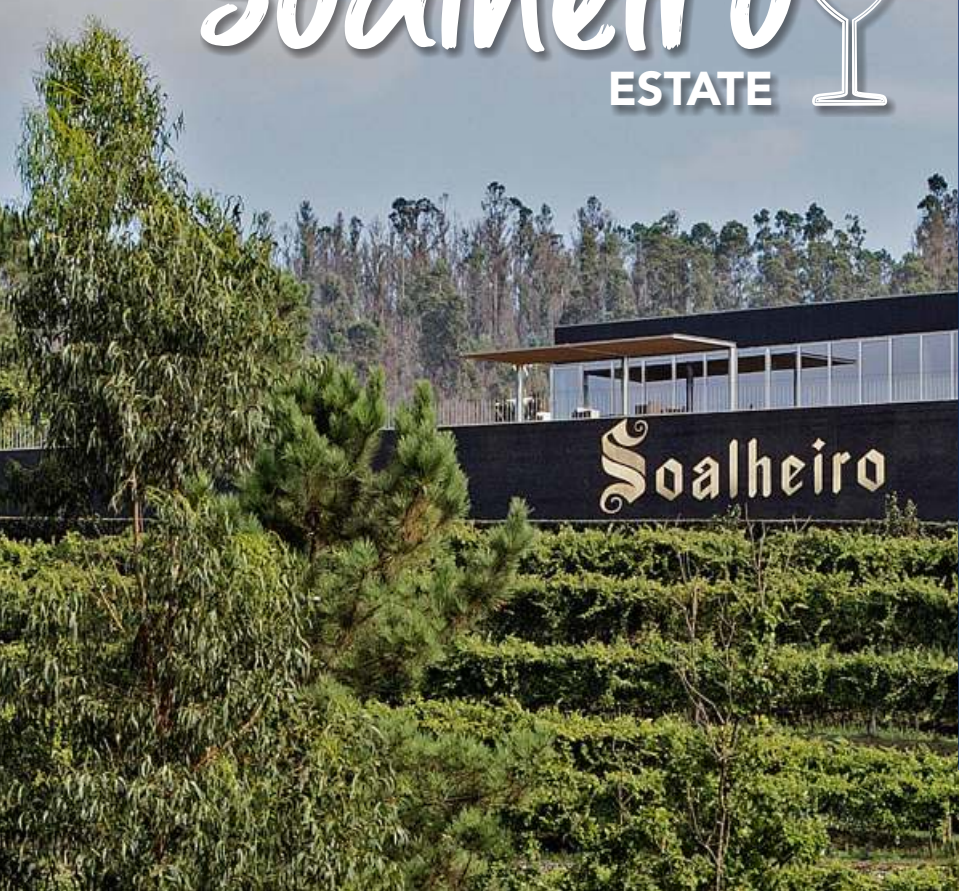

The wine farm situated in the north of Portugal is a specialist in the grape variety "Alvarinho" and was nominated as the 16th best vineyard by the World's best Vineyard publication.

In 1974, the year of Portugal's Carnation Revolution, João Antonio Cerdeira and his wife Palmira became the first people to plant Alvarinho grapes in Melgaço, in the northernmost part of the country's Vinho Verde region.

Originally working from his family's garage (in place of their old red Ford Estate), João produced wines under the Soalheiro name from 1982, including a pioneering sparkling Alvarinho in 1995.

Championing this white grape has become Soalheiro's modus operandi and its wines are globally recognized for their brightness and intensity.

# Esporão

ESTATE



The story begins in 1267, when the geographic boundaries of Herdade do Esporão (initially named Defesa do Esporão) were defined and have remained virtually unchanged to this day.

This wine farm is one of Portugal's most recognised brands. Esporão's vision is to make the finest products that nature provides in a responsible and inspiring way.

With evolving knowledge and experience, the estate is constantly improving organic farming techniques.



The wine farm in the heart of the Douro Valley, Portugal's best known wine region, is a rustic yet innovative winery started by Jorge Seródio Borges and his wife Sandra Tavares Silva, both accomplished winemakers.

Sandra was in 2020 nominated as one of the best female winemakers in the world. Their objective is to showcase the traditional grape varieties from the Douro on an international level.

## PORTUGUESE WINES



### SOALHEIRO ALLO 2018 R350

**Monção and Melgaço** - 50% Alvarinho 50% Loureiro from Monção and Melgaço. Yellow colour, citrus flavours with elegant and mineral profile. The Alvarinho, full of tropical fruit and structure, contrasts with the Loureiro, floral and full of elegance, which gives this white wine with 11% alcohol volume a unique balance.

### SOALHEIRO CLASSICO 2020 R485

**Monção and Melgaço** - 100% Alvarinho from Monção and Melgaço. The wine has a fresh and elegant fragrance. The flavour has intense tropical and mineral notes that balance perfectly with the acidity and moderate alcohol content of 12.5%.

### ESPORÃO RESERVA 2018 R575

**Alentejo** - A classic wine showcasing the consistency and rich character typical of the best Alentejo wines. Creamy, complex and balanced palate with elegant fruit and minerality, intense and persistent finish. Grape varieties Antão Vaz, Arinto and Roupeiro.

### WINE AND SOUL-MANOELLA 2020 R635

**Douro** - A blend of Gouveio, Viosinho, Rabigato and Códaga do Larinho of schist and granitic soils from a 53 year old vineyard in the Douro region. Vibrant and fresh wine with intense citric, floral and mineral notes. On the palate shows pure flavours and nice balance.

### VULCÂNICO 2019 R750

**Açores Island** - A wine from the base of the volcanic mountain, the Volcanic Series are wines of pure volcanic terroir. These infertile, rocky soils defy the definition of usable soil. Mineral and salty attack, it has the grape varieties and Azorean Terroir matrix, but with a much more exuberant, tropical aroma of the Azorean pineapple and passion fruit, fresh fruit with acidity. 85% Arinto dos Açores; Verdelho 15%.

### WINE AND SOUL-GURU 2020 R1030

**Douro** - This wine is sourced from a 57-year-old vineyard with a field blend of Gouveio, Viosinho, Rabigato and Códaga do Larinho of schist and granitic soils. Very elegant wine exhibiting pear quince fruit and mineral aromas, seriously sophisticated.

# Red

## PORTUGUESE WINES



### WINE AND SOUL-MANOELLA 2019 R635

**Douro** - This wine is sourced from a 39-year-old vineyard, which contains a field blend of over 40 indigenous varieties. The grapes are carefully selected and foot trodden in traditional granite lagares during the maceration and fermentation process. The wine is then aged for 16 months in French oak barriques. This wine shows amazing purity of flavour, with dark plum and spices, supported by elegant tannins and good freshness.

### ESPORÃO RESERVA 2016 R690

**Alentejo** - Aged for 12 months in American Oak (60%) and French (40%) oak barrels. After bottling, the wine is aged for a further 8 months in bottle. The grape varieties are Aragonez, Trincadeira, Alicante Bouschet & Cabernet Sauvignon.

### FITA PRETA PALPITE RESERVE 2019 R810

**Alentejo** - Palpite is the reserve red wine produced by Fita Preta Wines from a selection of the best vineyard blocks and finest barrels from every vintage. The grape varieties are Aragonés (Tempranillo) 42%, Alicante Bouschet 38%, Trincadeira 12%, Touriga nacional 8%.

### WINE AND SOUL-PINTAS CHARACTER 2018 R900

**Douro** - This wine is sourced from a 45-year-old vineyard, which contains a field blend of over 30 indigenous varieties. The grapes are carefully selected and foot trodden in traditional granite lagares during the maceration and fermentation process. The wine is then aged for 18 months in French oak barriques. Very rich and powerful red with notes of fresh black cherry, plum and raspberry. Long aftertaste with very well integrated and velvety tannins.

### WINE AND SOUL-MANOELLA VV 2018 R2560

**Douro** - This wine is sourced from a 108 year old vineyard which contains a field blend of over 30 indigenous varieties. The grapes are carefully selected and foot trodden in traditional granite lagares during the maceration and fermentation process. The wine is then aged for 20 months in French oak. Deep cherry red, very silky and elegant. Seductive fruit sweetness that fills the mouth and leaves it fresh with a dry mineral texture. This wine is one of the flagship wines for the whole Douro Valley.

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# White

## SOUTH AFRICAN WINES

### Saboteur White R405

**Cape South Coast** - Pale straw. Fresh orange peel, hint of potpourri, peach and apricot, lime blossom. White pear and lime on entry, broad tropical mid pallet with clean, fresh, salty, citrus finish. The wine is sealed with a Crown Cap. Grape Varieties Chenin Blanc, Viognier and wooded Sauvignon Blanc.

### Cape Point-Sauvignon Blanc Reserve R460

**Cape Town** - Cape Point Vineyards has one of the Cape's most unique locations, situated on the narrow southern tip of the Cape Peninsula, where it is set rather majestically against the slopes of the famous Chapman's Peak mountain range and overlooks the nearby Atlantic Ocean – a mere 1,2km's away. Sourced entirely from sites on granite soils, located in the upper part of the farm, this wooded Sauvignon Blanc with 10% Semillon wouldn't look out of place alongside a top Pessac-Léognan. Leesy, concentrated and skilfully oaked, it has lovely brine, green herb and oyster shell notes

### The Fledge-Vagabond R475

**Western Cape** - This wine is Chenin Blanc based with a medley of French, Portuguese and Spanish grapes from 16 vineyards. Fresh zippy and understated, it has negligible oak, pear, aniseed, lemon and lime flavours and a steely, low alcohol finish. Grape Varieties Chenin Blanc, Verdelho, Viognier.

### Newton Johnson South End Chardonnay R530

**Hemel and Aarde Valley** - This wine farm is world-famous for their fine Chardonnays and Pinot Noir. A wine with energy and intensity. The high-toned, rapier-like lime fruit is buoyed with sharp ginger, white pepper and flint. Crushed stones and saltiness sustain the refreshing appeal. Good weight of flavour in the mid palate boosted with bright acidity and grippy texture. Aged in 11% new wood, it's sappy, focused and refreshing, with lime and lemongrass flavours and a hint of struck match. Grape Variety 100% Chardonnay

### Cape Point Isliedh R780

**Western Cape** - Isliedh is a remarkable combination of Cape coastal Sauvignon Blanc drenched in richly textured Semillon. Both varieties adding to the complexity of the wine. The blend offers beautiful floral notes of white orchid, rose and peach blossom. The fruit leaps from the glass unveiling a harmonious blend of white fruits, ripe nectarine, pink grapefruit, figs and lemon curd. Hints of floral oak spice combined with fresh thyme gives the wine an extra layer of depth. The palate is rich, saline, full and textured with the classic long lasting mineral finish. **This wine is a consistent 5 star platter year after year.**

### Kaapzicht 1947 Chenin Blanc R1300

**Stellenbosch** - Kaapzicht is a 4th generation family owned wine estate. The block has been registered as a single vineyard and it's the second oldest Chenin Blanc vineyard in S.A. Only 900 bottles of this remarkable Chenin are produced, alas, so fight to get hold of one. It's a bush vine white of considerable complexity, with spicy, honeyed flavours, a hint of tangerine and a focused, palate-cleansing, mineral-etched finish. Old vine concentration at its best.

# Red

## SOUTH AFRICAN WINES

### Newton Johnston Full Stop Rock R520

**Hemel and Aarde Valley** - Rich and generous with its wild flavour. Brooding black fruits, liquorice and mulberry are laced with black and white pepper, topped with the sweet floral notes. Full liquorice flavour, with juicy red fruits in the periphery, and chewy tannins lasting in to the finish. Grape Variety 79% Syrah Grenache 21%.

### Luddite-Saboteur R560

**Bot river** - Ruby red and purple in colour, spice, cinnamon, tobacco and bright red fruits on the nose with a long and dry finish leaving the palate refreshed. This vintage was in barrel for 12 months with 18% new French oak. Grape variety 61% Syrah 15% Grenache Noir 13% Mourvedre 11% Cabernet Sauvignon.

### AA Badenhorst Ramnasgras R700

**Swartland** - Considered among the new age icons responsible for the Swartland's success, and a driving force behind the Swartland Revolution, Adi Badenhorst was one of the first to really believe in the area and purchased Kalmoesfontein back in 2008 with his cousin Hein.

This vineyard was planted in the mid 1950's on decomposed granite soils. It possesses great fruit of the red spectrum, earthiness and some lovely spice. The palate is delicious in its transparency of fruit flavours, fair acid grip and gentle tannins. Limited bottles produced. Grape Variety Cinsault.

### Keermont R700

**Stellenbosch** - Dark ruby red in colour, this vintage has a vibrant bouquet of ripe red berry fruit, cassia, vanilla pudding, and a hint of dried herbs. The pallet is soft and rich. The tannins are round and gentle, while the natural acidity keeps the ripe fruit in check. Savoury notes of cocoa and cloves add character to the bright red strawberry and mulberry flavours which linger into a long, luscious, juicy finish. Grape Variety Cabernet Sauvignon.

### Sadie Family Wines Treinspoor R1125

**Swartland** - Eben Sadie is South Africa's most revered winemaker and he arguably kick-started the local fine wine revolution. Over two decades his pursuit for quality in the Swartland has been unparalleled in South Africa and he was voted Winemaker of the Year in 2017 by the International Master of Wine Institute. This wine is sourced from a vineyard in the Swartland planted in 1974 made from a Portuguese grape variety Tinta Barocca. This wine boasts a wonderfully perfumed nose of fresh lavender, incense, fynbos and garrigue over a plush aromatic melange of blueberry reduction, black cherry and wood smoked dried herbs. The palate is cool, complex and compact with a fine soft fleshy black berry concentration that shows hints of Parma violet rock candy, grape jelly, pink musk, granitic minerality and finely textured chalky tannins. Grape Variety Tinta Barocca.

### Porseleinberg R2025

**Swartland** - Has any brand in South Africa achieved quite so much as Porseleinberg in less than a decade? One of the world's great reds from a very special site. Big, bold and intense, with incredible, almost feral intensity, incense, tar and black pepper aromas and layers of inky dark fruit. A stunning wine from a stunning site, made by a gem of a winemaker. Grape variety 100% Syrah.
